The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is now accepting applications for Police Officer 2A. Good benefits including fourteen paid holidays per year. Annual pay increases. Excellent Tuition Exemption Program after two consecutive years of service.

Minimum Qualifications: One year experience in law enforcement work; college training may be substituted for the required experience on the basis of thirty semester hours for the one year of experience; must have attained eighteenth birthday at the time of application. An applicant who has been convicted of a felony or who is under indictment on a felony charge will be disqualified until relief from the disabilities imposed by State or Federal law is granted.

Note: Example of experience accepted as law enforcement are police officers commissioned with the power of arrest, military police, and deputy sheriffs. Examples of experience not accepted as law enforcement are correctional officers and private security guards.

Must have a score for the 7500-LEAPS Exam. If qualifications are based on college hours earned, you must also submit an official college transcript. Must also possess a valid Louisiana driver's license. An offer of employment is contingent on passing a psychological and drug test.
